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WHEREAS, provisions of state law provide authority to mayors throughout the state to make appointments on behalf of cities to various bodies; and

WHEREAS, in keeping with the spirit of the Charter of the City of Culver City, the City Council works collaboratively in making policy decisions, including an opportunity for the public to provide input; and

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Culver City DOES HEREBY
RESOLVE, as follows:

2. Notwithstanding Section 1 hereof, the Mayor may exercise any authority provided under state law to make appointments in the case such appointment is required to

1 be made in conjunction with the existence of an emergency. Any such appointments shall be
2 subject to the review and approval of the City Council at the first meeting convened after such
3 emergency appointments are made.

4 3. In the case the City Council does not consent to an appointment made by
5 the Mayor, such appointment shall immediately be suspended and the City Council, by a
6 majority vote of those members present, may direct the Mayor to present another nominee for
7 consideration by the City Council.

8 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.

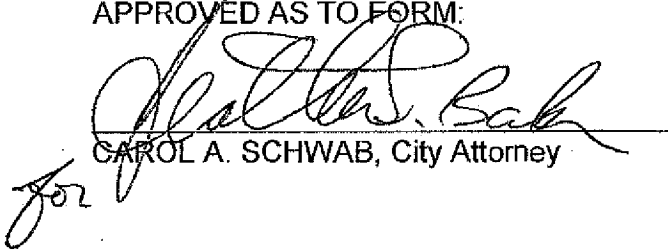
