



1           **WHEREAS**, local jurisdictions must update their Hazard Mitigation Plans and  
2 resubmit them for FEMA approval every five years to remain eligible for certain types of  
3 funding assistance; and

4           **WHEREAS**, as such, and in accordance with FEMA requirements at 44  
5 C.F.R. § 201.6, the City of Culver City and CCUSD have, once again, completed a  
6 coordinated planning process that engaged the public, assessed the risk and vulnerability  
7 to the impacts of natural hazards, developed a mitigation strategy consistent with a set of  
8 uniform goals and objectives, and created a plan for implementing, evaluating, and revising  
9 the strategy; and  
10

11           **WHEREAS**, residents of the City of Culver City were awarded opportunities to  
12 comment and provide input on the Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan and the  
13 actions in the plan by completing a survey, attending two special events hosted by the City,  
14 and via the City's website; and  
15

16           **WHEREAS**, on June 21, 2024, the Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan  
17 2024 was approved as written by FEMA, pending adoption by the participating jurisdictions;  
18 and

20           **WHEREAS**, to ensure eligibility for funding under FEMA's Hazard Mitigation  
21 Assistance programs, formal adoption documentation must be submitted to FEMA Region  
22 9 by at least one participating jurisdiction within one calendar year of FEMA's conditional  
23 approval, after which FEMA will approve the plan; and  
24

25           **WHEREAS**, all participating agencies must adopt the plan within five calendar  
26 years of the date of approval.

27           **NOW, THEREFORE**, the City Council of the City of Culver City, **DOES**  
28 **HEREBY RESOLVE** as follows:

1                   The Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan, attached as Exhibit "A", is  
2 hereby approved and adopted by the City of Culver City.
