<u>RECOMMENDATION:</u> Staff recommends the City Council and Redevelopment Agency receive an overview presentation on the Fiscal Years 2009-10 and 2010-11 Proposed Budget for the Public Works Department, including Refuse and Sewer Divisions, Capital Improvement Projects, and Parks, Recreation and Community Services Department. <u>DISCUSSION:</u> The first budget study session of the Fiscal Years 2009-10 and 2010-11 Proposed Budget occurred on May 26, 2009. The Chief Financial Officer gave a presentation to City Council, which included a discussion of current economic conditions, insight into how government finances work, and provided financial highlights for the Proposed Budget. Presentations by the Police Department, Fire Department and Transportation Department were heard on Thursday, June 4, 2009. On Thursday, June 11 presentations were heard for the Public Works Department, including Refuse and Sewer Divisions, Capital Improvement Projects, and Parks, Recreation and Community Services Department.
