 <u>RECOMMENDATION:</u> Staff recommends that the City Council adopt an Ordinance amending Chapter 5.03, Water Conservation, of the Culver City Municipal Code. <u>BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION:</u> At the City Council meeting of October 12, 2009, the City Council introduced the Ordinance by a unanimous vote (5-0). The Ordinance is brought back for adoption. <u>FISCAL ANALYSIS:</u> Staff does not anticipate that the Ordinance will require significant additional expenditures. However, it could lead to somewhat lower tax revenues. Sewer charges are based on water use and the Utility Users Tax is applied to water bills. To the extent that this Ordinance leads to lower water consumption, it will lead to commensurate drops in these revenue sources, assuming no changes in sewer charge or water rates. The amount of these changes is difficult to estimate at this time. <u>ATTACHMENTS:</u> 1. Ordinance
