<u>RECOMMENDATION:</u> Staff recommends the City Council appoint Elena Sweda-Neff to the position of Trustee on the Board of Trustees of the Los Angeles County West Vector Control District to fill the remainder of a two-year term ending December 31, 2010 and for the two-year term beginning January 1, 2011 and ending December 31, 2012. <u>BACKGROUND:</u> The City of Culver City is entitled to appoint a representative (Trustee) to the Los Angeles County West Vector Control District. The Vector Control District is empowered to undertake and carry out a number of abatement and control duties under the California Health and Safety Code pertaining to mosquito and vector control. This position was previously filled by Lupe Mercado with her term ending December 31, 2008. The position has been vacant since that time. The Trustee is required to be a resident and registered voter of the City. <u>DISCUSSION:</u> Since the position became vacant on December 31, 2008, the City has advertised for this opportunity and received no interest until Elena Sweda-Neff approached staff and expressed interest in serving as a Trustee. Mrs. Sweda-Neff is a resident of the City and a registered voter as required.			

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FISCAL ANALYSIS:

There is no fiscal impact to the City. Trustees are paid a stipend in the amount of \$50 per meeting to compensate them for their time and expenses in attending bi-monthly meetings of the Vector Control District. This stipend is paid by the Vector Control District.
