

1 RESOLUTION NO. 2017-R\_\_\_\_\_

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3 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
4 CULVER CITY, CALIFORNIA, CONFIRMING THE  
5 ASSESSMENT AND ORDERING THE LEVY FOR THE  
6 SEWER USER'S SERVICE CHARGES FOR FISCAL YEAR  
7 2017-2018.

8 WHEREAS, the City Council previously completed proceedings in  
9 accordance with the provisions of Chapter 5.02 of the Culver City Municipal Code  
10 ("CCMC") for the levy and collection of annual assessments for the system of sewer  
11 user's service charges providing that each parcel of property shall pay its proportionate  
12 share of the costs for operation, maintenance, repair and improvements of the City  
13 sewerage system (the "Sewer User's Service Charges"); and,

14 WHEREAS, on May 30, 2017, the City Council approved the Assessment  
15 Engineer's Report (the "Engineer's Report") and declared its intention to provide for the  
16 levy and collection of annual assessments for Fiscal Year 2017-2018, to provide for the  
17 costs and expenses necessary for the operation, maintenance, repair and  
18 improvements of the City sewerage system; and,

19 WHEREAS, as set forth in the Engineer's Report, the maximum  
20 assessment is proposed to increase from the previous year above that previously  
21 approved by the property owners per consumer price index increase from February  
22 2016 to February 2017 (as "increased assessment" is defined in California  
23 Government Code §54954.6); and,

24 WHEREAS, the City Council has heard all testimony and considered all  
25 objections to the assessment at a duly noticed public hearing held on July 24, 2017 and  
26 has determined to proceed with the levy of annual assessments for the District.  
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1           NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Culver City, DOES  
2   HEREBY RESOLVE as follows:

3           1.     Pursuant to CCMC Section 5.02.035.D, the City Council hereby  
4   overrides any objections and confirms the assessment and the allocation of the levy  
5   amounts so that each parcel of property shall pay its proportionate share of the costs  
6   for operation, maintenance, repair and improvements of the City sewerage system, as  
7   is described in full detail in the Engineer's Report on file with the Clerk.  
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9           2.     The adoption of this resolution shall constitute the levy of an  
10   assessment for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2017 and ending June 30, 2018.

11          3.     The assessment for the Sewer User's Service Charges as set forth  
12   in the Engineer's Report shall be performed pursuant to law. The County Auditor shall  
13   enter on the County Assessment Roll the amount of the assessment and the  
14   assessment shall be collected at the same time and in the same manner as the County  
15   property taxes are collected. After collection by the County, the net amount of the  
16   assessment shall be paid to the City of Culver City.  
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18          4.     Upon receipt of monies representing assessments collected by the  
19   County, the City shall deposit the monies into a special fund known as the "Fund for  
20   Sewer User's Service Charges" which was previously established upon the creation of  
21   the District.  
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23          5.     Immediately upon the adoption of this Resolution, the City Clerk  
24   shall file a certified copy of this Resolution, which includes the Engineer's Report  
25   containing the allocation of levy amounts and assessment, with the County Auditor.

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2           6.     A certified copy of the Engineer's Report shall also be filed in the  
3 Office of the City Engineer, with a duplicate copy on file in the Office of the City Clerk,  
4 and shall be open for public inspection.
