<u>RECOMMENDATION:</u> Staff recommends the City Council adopt an Ordinance (Attachment 1) amending Culver City Municipal Code § 9.10.300.B to authorize the City Council to establish, by resolution, skateboard park rules and regulations and waive further reading. <u>BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION:</u> At the City Council meeting of August 13, 2007, the Council introduced the Ordinance and adopted the Resolution establishing the specific regulations, by a unanimous vote (5-0). The Resolution will take effect concurrently with the effective date of the Ordinance. The Ordinance is brought back at this time for adoption. <u>FISCAL ANALYSIS:</u> The rules and regulations will be posted at the entrance of the newly constructed Skateboard Park. There are sufficient funds in Grants account 42300830.730100 (Skateboard Park Project – Improvements other than Building) to cover the cost of fabricating and installing the sign, which is estimated to be approximately \$300 - \$500. <u>ATTACHMENTS:</u> 1.
