RESOLUTION NO. 2007-R_____

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
CULVER CITY, CALIFORNIA, APPROVING THE
APPLICATION FOR GRANT FUNDS FROM THE BALDWIN
HILLS CONSERVANCY FOR PROPOSITION 40 FUNDING
FOR THE CULVER CITY SKATEBOARD PARK PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the people of the State of California on March 5, 2002, enacted
State of California Proposition 40, the California Clean Water, Clean Air, Safe
Neighborhood Parks, and Coastal Protection Act of 2002, which among other uses,
provides funds to public agencies and nonprofit organizations in the State for the purpose
of development, restoration, and acquisition of state and local parks, recreation areas and
historical resources, and for land, air, and water conservation programs; and

WHEREAS, the Baldwin Hills Conservancy has set forth the necessary
procedures governing application for grant funds under the Proposition; and

WHEREAS, the Conservancy's procedures require the City Council of the
City of Culver City to certify, by resolution, the approval of the application before
submission of said application(s) to the Conservancy; and

WHEREAS, said application contains assurances that the City Council of
the City of Culver City must comply with; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Culver City will enter into an
Agreement with the Conservancy to provide funds for acquisition and development
projects.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Culver City, California
DOES HEREBY RESOLVE as follows:

1 1. Approves the filing of an application with the Baldwin Hills
2 Conservancy for Proposition 40 Funds for the above project; and

3 2. Certifies that the City Council of the City of Culver City understands
4 the assurances and certification in the application form; and

5 3. Certifies that the City Council of the City of Culver City has, or will
6 have, sufficient funds to operate and maintain the project in perpetuity; or has the right to
7 assign maintenance to another agency; and

9 4. Authorizes and appoints the City Manager of the City of Culver City
10 or designee, to conduct all negotiations, and to execute and submit all documents
11 including, but not limited to, applications, agreements, amendments, payment requests
12 and so forth, which may be necessary for the completion of the aforementioned project.
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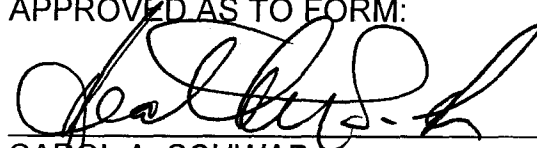
