

CULVER CITY DISTRICT TAXES HIGHLIGHTS

Tax receipts from Culver City's voter-approved district taxes, Measure CC (0.50%) and Measure C (0.25%), decreased by 0.6% from April to June compared to the same period in 2023. However, after accounting for payment irregularities—most notably an influx of tax revenue from a motion picture and equipment company in the comparison year tied to earlier sales activity—the adjusted figures show a 1.2% increase in actual sales.

This growth slightly surpassed the City's Bradley-Burns sales tax performance, largely due to the broader tax base of the district taxes, which were less impacted by the decline in new car sales. The increase was further supported by several new business openings

over the past year, including restaurants, a family apparel store, and a convenience or liquor store.

The largest sales tax category, general consumer goods, continued to benefit from strong online shopping activity. Discount retailers also performed well, as consumers prioritized convenience and savings, though other retail sectors like department stores, specialty shops, shoe stores, and women's apparel experienced declines as financial pressures led to reduced spending.

In comparison, taxable sales across Los Angeles County and the broader Southern California region both fell by 0.5%, excluding anomalies.


