**Items from Disability Advisory Committee Members/Staff**

Member Sookne reported receipt of a complaint about changes made to the Circulator Bus that have caused accessibility issues making it very hard to get on and off and difficult to communicate with the driver.

Discussion ensued between staff and Committee Members regarding interest in agendaing the topic for discussion, but inability to agenda topics during the current item.

Member Goldhaber discussed falling while getting off a Culver CityBus due to a Ficus tree and she noted that she might bring up the item at another time for further conversation.

Chair Albertson reported representing the Disability Advisory Committee (DAC) for the Sepulveda Connects Community Public Advisory Council; discussed upcoming meetings; the focus of the group to make the Sepulveda Corridor more efficient and accessible; sharing accessibility concerns; continued advocacy; and she indicated that she would bring back anything to share after the meetings.

Member Goldhaber received clarification that Chair Albertson had been invited by the Sepulveda Connects Community Public Advisory Council to represent the DAC and provide input.

Jill Thomsen, Recreation and Community Services Supervisor, reported that the new City Manager was doing a series of public conversations called Let's Talk Culver City open to everyone; she discussed upcoming meetings; and she was pleased that Sepulveda Connects had reached out to the Chair for participation.

Jesse Roth, Associate Analyst, apologized for missing the last meeting; noted that the date for City Council consideration of biannual reports had been changed to February 23, 2026; she indicated that she would confirm that

the Chair is allowed to provide input for that meeting and to let everyone know so they can go to support if they choose to; reported that contact information was posted on the Culver City website to accept feedback regarding accessibility issues with the Circulator and CityBus; she shared the contact information with Committee Members and encouraged anyone with concerns to reach out to them; she expressed appreciation to Vice Chair Lo for his presentation and acknowledged a great turnout; she thanked Nick Adams and Nancy Ruvalcaba for their help in setting everything up; and she thanked everyone for their support.

Member Goldhaber reported that Dr. Jay Shery had passed away noting that he had previously served as Chair of the DAC for many years.

Discussion ensued between staff and Committee Members regarding the life and legacy of Dr. Jay Shery; his advocacy and kindness; and a suggestion to send a note to Dr. Shery's wife.
