3 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
4 CULVER CITY, CALIFORNIA, APPROVING AN APPLICATION
5 FOR GRANT FUNDS FROM THE BALDWIN HILLS
6 CONSERVANCY FOR PROPOSITION 84 FUNDING FOR
7 DESIGN OF A RAMP AT THE HIGUERA BRIDGE TO
8 IMPROVE PEDESTRIAN AND BICYCLE ACCESS TO
9 BALLONA CREEK

10 WHEREAS, the Safe Drinking Water, Water Quality and Supply, Flood
11 Control, River and Coastal Protection Bond Act of 2006 (Proposition 84), was adopted
12 by California voters in the general election on November 7, 2006, which among other
13 uses, provides funds to public agencies and nonprofit organizations in the State for the
14 purpose of preventing contamination and degradation of coastal waters and
15 watersheds, protecting and restoring the natural habitat values of coastal waters and
16 lands, promoting access to and enjoyment of the coastal resources of the state; and

17 WHEREAS, the Baldwin Hills Conservancy ("BHC") has set forth the
18 necessary procedures governing application for grant funds under Proposition 84; and

19 WHEREAS, the BHC's procedures require the City of Culver City to
20 certify, by resolution, the approval of the application before submission of the
21 application(s) to the BHC; and

22 WHEREAS, the application contains assurances with which the City of
23 Culver City must comply; and

24 WHEREAS, if the application is approved by the BHC, the City of Culver
25 City will enter into an Agreement with the BHC to provide funds for the design of a ramp
26 at the Higuera Bridge to the Ballona Creek Bike Path (the "Project").

27 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Culver City DOES
28 HEREBY RESOLVE:

1. The filing of an application with the Baldwin Hills Conservancy for

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Proposition 84 Funds for the Project is hereby approved; and

2. The City of Culver City hereby certifies that it understands the assurances and certification in the application form; and

3. The City Council hereby appoints the City Manager, or his designee, to conduct all negotiations, and to execute and submit all documents including, but not limited to, applications, agreements, amendments and payment requests, which may be necessary for the completion of the Project.
