

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-R_____

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
CULVER CITY, CALIFORNIA, UPDATING THE PURCHASING
OFFICER'S PURCHASING AUTHORITY.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Culver City Municipal Code ("CCMC") Section
3.07.010, the City Council shall establish the purchasing and contracting authority of the
City's Purchasing Officer; and

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 2018-R024 on March 26,
2018, which authorized the City's Purchasing Officer to approve any purchase order or
contract (collectively, "Purchasing Authority") where the aggregate amount of compensation
for a particular vendor (e.g., suppliers, contractors, consultants, etc.) does not exceed the
amount of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000) in a single fiscal year.

WHEREAS, in consideration of the growing number of contracts beyond the
existing Purchasing Authority, requiring significant staff time involved in preparing an item
for a City Council agenda, as well as the fact that the Purchasing Authority has not been
increased over the last eight years, the City Council has determined that the Purchasing
Authority should be increased.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Culver City, California,
DOES HEREBY RESOLVE as follows:

1. Except as otherwise specifically provided in CCMC Chapter 3.07, the
Purchasing Officer or authorized designee shall be authorized to approve any purchase order
or contract (collectively, "Purchasing Authority") where the aggregate amount of
compensation for a particular vendor (e.g. suppliers, contractors, consultants, etc.) does not
exceed the amount of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000) in a single fiscal year.
