A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CULVER CITY, CALIFORNIA, APPROVING A FINAL ENGINEER'S REPORT AND CONFIRMING THE ASSESSMENT AND ORDERING THE LEVY FOR THE SEWER USER'S SERVICE CHARGES FOR FISCAL YEAR 2019-2020.

WHEREAS, the City Council previously completed proceedings in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 5.02 of the Culver City Municipal Code ("CCMC") for the levy and collection of annual assessments for the system of sewer user's service charges providing that each parcel of property shall pay its proportionate share of the costs for operation, maintenance, repair and improvements of the City sewerage system (the "Sewer User's Service Charges"); and,

WHEREAS, on April 22, 2019, the City Council preliminarily approved the Assessment Engineer's Report (the "Engineer's Report") and declared its intention to provide for the levy and collection of annual assessments for Fiscal Year 2019-2020, to provide for the costs and expenses necessary for the operation, maintenance, repair and improvements of the City sewerage system; and,

WHEREAS, the Engineer's Report adopted on April 22, 2019 included a mathematical error in the industrial user classification rate. The error was identified in the Engineer's Report prior to the 45-day Public Notification period. The Public Notice was updated, and rate payers were notified of the correct proposed rates. This is reflected in the proposed service charge rates table in the final Engineer's Report; and

WHEREAS, as set forth in the final Engineer's Report, the maximum assessment is proposed to increase from the previous year above that previously approved by the City Council (as "increased assessment" is defined in California Government Code §54954.6); and,

WHEREAS, the City Council has heard all testimony and considered all objections to the assessment at a duly noticed public hearing held on June 10, 2019 and has determined to proceed with the levy of annual assessments for the District.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Culver City, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE as follows:

- 1. The final Engineer's Report, consisting of the following: a description of the operation, maintenance, repair and improvements of the City sewerage system, the estimated costs of operation, maintenance, repair and improvements, and the formulas used to determine the sewer user service charges for the parcels, is hereby approved and is on file in the Office of the City Clerk open for public inspection.
- 2. Pursuant to CCMC Section 5.02.035.D, the City Council hereby overrules any objections and confirms the assessment and the allocation of the levy amounts so that each parcel of property shall pay its proportionate share of the costs for operation, maintenance, repair and improvements of the City sewerage system, as is described in full detail in the Engineer's Report on file with the Clerk.
- 3. The adoption of this resolution shall constitute the levy of an assessment for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2019 and ending June 30, 2020.
- 4. The assessment for the Sewer User's Service Charges as set forth in the Engineer's Report shall be performed pursuant to law. The County Auditor shall

enter on the County Assessment Roll the amount of the assessment and the assessment shall be collected at the same time and in the same manner as the County property taxes are collected. After collection by the County, the net amount of the assessment shall be paid to the City of Culver City.

- 5. Upon receipt of monies representing assessments collected by the County, the City shall deposit the monies into a special fund known as the "Fund for Sewer User's Service Charges" which was previously established upon the creation of the District.
- 6. Immediately upon the adoption of this Resolution, the City Clerk shall file a certified copy of this Resolution, which includes the final Engineer's Report containing the allocation of levy amounts and assessment, with the County Auditor.
- 7. A certified copy of the Engineer's Report shall also be filed in the Office of the City Engineer, with a duplicate copy on file in the Office of the City Clerk, and shall be open for public inspection.
