

RESOLUTION NO. 2025-R_____

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CULVER CITY, CALIFORNIA, ACCEPTING \$2,375 IN 2024 STATE HOMELAND SECURITY PROGRAM GRANT FUNDS FOR OVERTIME AND BACKFILL FOR CULVER CITY FIRE DEPARTMENT PERSONNEL TO ATTEND UNIFIED RESPONSE VIOLENT INCIDENTS TRAINING, AND PROVIDING PROOF OF AUTHORITY AS REQUIRED BY THE CALIFORNIA OFFICE OF EMERGENCY SERVICES.

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Homeland Security (DHS), through its Office of Grants and Training, provides financial assistance to the 2024 State Homeland Security Program (SHSP), through the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services (Cal OES), to address unique equipment, training, organization, exercise and planning needs to assist emergency personnel throughout the state to build effective prevention and protection capabilities to prevent, respond to, and recover from threats or acts of terrorism; and

WHEREAS, on October 28, 2024, the DHS made a federal award to SHSP directly to Cal OES with a performance period of September 1, 2024, to May 31, 2027; and

WHEREAS, Cal OES provides funds to various California counties, including the County of Los Angeles, as its Subgrantees, with said funds being distributed by the counties to other specified jurisdictions within each county; and

WHEREAS, in the 2024 regional application for SHSP funds, the Culver City Fire Department (CCFD) included a request for funding for overtime and backfill for Fire personnel to attend Unified Response Violent Incidents (URVI) training (CCFD Project); and

WHEREAS, the County of Los Angeles notified CCFD that the City of Culver City, as a Subrecipient, was awarded the amount of \$2,375 to fund the CCFD Project; and

WHEREAS, the performance period for the CCFD Project ends on February 28, 2027; and

WHEREAS, as a requirement of obtaining the 2024 SHSP grant funds, the City Council must provide written Proof of Authority in support of the Project for which the SHSP grant funds will be used, and agree to the provisions of the 2024 Grant Assurances;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Culver City DOES

HEREBY RESOLVE as follows:

- 1. The City Council hereby authorizes and supports the CCFD Project for which CCFD will use the 2024 SHSP grant funds.
- 2. By the adoption of this Resolution, the City Council provides this Proof of Authority as required by the Cal OES Standard Assurances and agrees as follows:
 - (a) To provide all matching funds required for the grant project and that any cash match will be appropriated as required;
 - (b) Any liability arising out of the performance of this agreement shall be the responsibility of the Applicant City, and the City Council, as the authorized governing body of the City;

1	(c) Grant funds shall not be used to supplant
2	expenditures controlled by the City Council;
3	(d) Applicant City is authorized by the City Council to
4	apply for federal assistance, and the institutional,
5	managerial, and financial capability (including funds
6	sufficient to pay the non-federal share of project cost, if any)
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8	to ensure proper planning, management, and completion of
9	the CCFD Project; and
10	(e) The City Manager, who is the official executing the
11	agreement is, in fact, authorized to do so.
