ORAL COMMENTS: Speakers must register to speak online at www.culvercity.org/agendas. Speakers will be called in chronological order, based on when they registered. At the start of each agenda item, staff will read aloud the names of those who have requested to speak on an agenda item. Requests to speak must be received before the start of the public comment period for that agenda item or will not be considered.
