October

- 3 weeks of pink in recognition of Breast Cancer Awareness Month
- 1 week of orange in celebration of Halloween

November

- 1 week of lights resembling the American Flag in recognition of Veterans Day
- 3 weeks of yellow and orange lights in celebration of fall

December

- 1 week of blue and white lights in celebration of Hanukkah
- 1 week of red, black, and yellow stripes in celebration of Kwanzaa
- 1 week of red and green lights in celebration of Christmas
- 1 week of neutral shimmering lights

January

- 4 weeks of bright twinkling lights in celebration of the New Year

February

- 1 week of orange and green in observance of Ramadan
- 1 week of red and yellow in celebration of Lunar New Year
- 2 weeks of pink in celebration of Valentine's Day

March

- 2 weeks of green and purple in recognition of Women's History Month
- 2 weeks of green in celebration of St. Patrick's Day

April

- 2 weeks of bright twinkling lights
- 1 week of blue lights in recognition of Autism Awareness Month
- 1 week of blue and green lights in recognition of Earth Day

May

- 1 week of blue and green in recognition of Asian Pacific Islander's Month
- 1 week of pink in celebration of Mother's Day
- 1 week of blue and white in recognition of Jewish Heritage Month
- 1 week of red and blue stripes in recognition of Memorial Day

June

- 1 week of blue and yellow in recognition of Caribbean-American Heritage Month
- 1 week of blue lights in celebration of Father's Day
- 1 week of rainbow stripes in celebration of Pride Month
- 1 week of red, black, and yellow stripes and the color green in commemoration of Juneteenth
