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A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CULVER CITY, CALIFORNIA, APPROVING AN APPLICATION FOR SANTA MONICA BAY RESTORATION COMMISSION PROPOSITION 84 GRANT PROGRAM FUNDS FOR THE CULVER BOULEVARD MEDIAN INFILTRATION PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the people of the State of California on November 2006 enacted the Safe Drinking Water, Water Quality and Supply, Flood Control, River and Coastal Protection Bond Act of 2006 (Proposition 84) for coastal water quality improvement projects; and

WHEREAS, the Santa Monica Bay Restoration Commission (SMBRC) is an independent, non-regulatory State entity charged with promoting comprehensive watershed and coastal resources management of Santa Monica Bay; and

WHEREAS, Proposition 84 allocates \$90 million to the State Water Resources Control Board for coastal water quality improvement projects, including projects to prevent contamination and degradation of coastal waters and watersheds; and

WHEREAS, applications for grant funding by the State Water Resources Control Board under Proposition 84 are to be submitted to and reviewed by the Santa Monica Bay Restoration Commission, which will then make recommendations to the State Water Resources Control Board for funding under the Proposition 84 grant program; and

WHEREAS, the Santa Monica Bay Restoration Commission has set forth the necessary procedures governing application for the Proposition 84 grant program; and

WHEREAS, the SMBRC's procedures require applicant to demonstrate stakeholder support for their projects, such as a council resolution, as part of their proposal, prior to project recommendation by the SMBRC; and

WHEREAS, the application form contains assurances with which applicant must comply; and

1 WHEREAS, the City of Culver City, as applicant or project proponent, is applying
2 for grant funds in support of the Culver Boulevard Median Infiltration Project (the "Project")
3 and certifies through this Resolution that this application is approved for submission to the
4 SMBRC; and

5 WHEREAS, the City of Culver City will enter into a Project Agreement with the
6 SMBRC to provide funds for the Project as described in the application.

7 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Culver City, DOES HEREBY
8 RESOLVE as follows:

9 1. The filing of an application for the Santa Monica Bay Restoration
10 Commission Proposition 84 Grant Program is hereby approved; and

11 2. The City of Culver City hereby certifies that it understands the assurances
12 and certifications in the grant application; and

13 3. The City of Culver City hereby certifies that it has, or will have, sufficient
14 funds to provide the matching funds required by the Santa Monica Bay Restoration
15 Commission Proposition 84 Grant Program; and

16 4. The City of Culver City certifies that it will sign and return, within 30 days,
17 both copies of the Project Agreement sent by the SMBRC for authorizing signature; and

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5. The City Manager, or designee, as agent of the City of Culver City, is hereby authorized to conduct all negotiations, and to execute and submit all documents including, but not limited to, applications, agreements, amendments, payment requests and so forth, which may be necessary for the completion of this grant application.
