1. Proposed Ordinance

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1 clarify that there does not exist public alleys subject to time-limited parking, as parking in
2 public alleys is prohibited by State law.

3 **NOW THEREFORE**, the City Council of the City of Culver City, California,
4 **DOES HEREBY ORDAIN** as follows:

5 **SECTION 1.** Section 7.03.305.A.1 is hereby amended to read as follows
6 (deletions indicated by ~~strike-through~~ text and additions indicated by underlined text):

7 7.03.305 PROHIBITIONS.

8 When preferential parking zones have been authorized by the City Council,
9 and signs have been posted giving notice of preferential parking zone restrictions, it shall
10 be unlawful:

11 A.1. For any person to park a vehicle on any public street ~~or alley~~ subject to a
12 "Time-Limited Parking Except By Permit" limitation for a period longer than the subject time
13 limitation, unless a preferential parking zone permit therefor has been issued by the City of
14 Culver City and is displayed on the vehicle. For purposes of this Section, successive acts
15 of parking upon any public street subject to a "Time-Limited Parking Except By Permit"
16 limitation, or portion of such street within the same preferential parking zone, shall be
17 deemed a single act of parking, subject to the time-limit parking restriction applicable to
18 that preferential parking zone.

19 **SECTION 2.** Section 7.03.305.A.1 is hereby amended to read as follows
20 (deletions indicated by ~~strike-through~~ text):

21 7.03.305 PROHIBITIONS.

22 When preferential parking zones have been authorized by the City Council,
23 and signs have been posted giving notice of preferential parking zone restrictions, it shall
24 be unlawful:

25 B.1. For any person to park a vehicle on any public street ~~or alley~~ subject to a
26 "No Parking Anytime Except By Permit" limitation, unless a preferential parking zone permit
27 therefor has been issued by the City of Culver City and is displayed on the vehicle.

SECTION 4. The City Council hereby declares that, if any provision, section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, phrase or word of this ordinance is rendered or declared invalid or unconstitutional by any final action in a court of competent jurisdiction or by reason of any preemptive legislation, then the City Council would have independently adopted the remaining provisions, sections, subsections, paragraphs, sentences, phrases or words of this ordinance and as such they shall remain in full force and effect.
