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MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

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This AGREEMENT is made and entered into by and between the Disaster Council of the City of Culver City, hereinafter "City", and the Culver City Amateur Radio Emergency Services organization, hereinafter "CCARES":

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties agree as follows:

- 1) In the event of a declared Local Emergency as specified in Section 12-6 of the Culver City Municipal Code, the CCARES leadership shall report to the designated Communications Officer at the City's Emergency Operations Center, who shall be responsible for coordinating CCARES services with City emergency activities.
- 2) CCARES and the City agree to work cooperatively in the development of standard operating procedures for the effective use of volunteers with expertise in radio communications to assist the City during emergencies.
- To provide protection to CCARES members assisting the City in Emergencies and in authorized training to prepare for emergencies, all members of CCARES shall be designated as *Disaster Service Workers* in accordance with the rules and regulations established by the Governor's Emergency Council, as provided for in Section 8580 of the California Government Code and as defined by Section 3211.92 of the California Labor Code.
- 4) CCARES members shall not hold themselves out as official representatives of the City; and shall wear no badges or insignias implying they have been endowed with police powers within the City;
- 5) Violations of the conditions contained in this document shall result in the removal of the violator from the rolls of authorized CCARES members as established by and kept on file with the City.

6) EFFECTIVE DATE:

The effective date of this Agreement is the date it is signed on behalf of the City.
