At the June 16, 2025, regular meeting of the Martin Luther King Jr. Celebration & Juneteenth Celebration Advisory Committee (Committee), the Committee discussed and approved a staff report of activity and authorized staff to transmit the final report to City Council for approval. The list below summarizes the CBC's accomplishments during the period of January through June 2025 and provides a list of anticipated activities/upcoming agenda items for the second half of the 2025 calendar year. The Committee regularly meets on the third Wednesday of every month and met eight times from January 9, 2025 through June 16, 2025.

List of Accomplishments

- Formed an Ad Hoc Subcommittee to draft a budget letter to transmit to the City Council for additional funding for Martin Luther King Jr. Celebration and & Juneteenth Celebration events.
 - Wrote and submitted a budget recommendation letter to the City Council for fiscal Year 2025-2026.
- Amended the PR and Marketing for Juneteenth Ad Hoc Subcommittee to add Martin Luther King Celebration to meet with staff and support in the planning of both celebrations.
- On January 13, 2025, the Committee accepted the proclamation from the City Council, proclaiming January 20, 2025 as "Dr. Martin Luther Jr. Day" in Culver City.

- On February 10, 2025 the Committee accepted the proclamation from the City Council, recognizing February as Black History Month.
- Hosted alongside the Parks, Recreation and Community Services Department the Committee's first Martin Luther King Jr. Celebration on February 15,2025, with approximately 300 people in attendance
- On June 9, 2025 the Committee accepted the proclamation from the City Council, in celebration of Juneteenth.
- Hosted alongside the Community and Economic Development Department the Committee's first Juneteenth Celebration on June 21, 2025, with an estimated 400 people in attendance throughout the day.

Scheduled Activities Plan:

- Continue planning and expanding the scope and concept, of the Committee's Second Martin Luther King Jr. Celebration in collaboration with the Parks, Recreation, and Community Services Department.
- Continue planning and expanding the scope and concept, of the Committee's Second Martin Luther King Jr. Celebration in collaboration with the Economic Development Department.
- Sending committee members to participate in 2028 Summer Olympic Ad Hoc Sub Committee meetings the Committee in
