4 CULVER CITY, CALIFORNIA, APPROVING A JOINT
5 APPLICATION WITH THE CITIES OF MONROVIA AND
6 CLAREMONT FOR GRANT FUNDS FOR THE
7 SUSTAINABLE COMMUNITIES PLANNING GRANT AND
8 INCENTIVES PROGRAM UNDER THE SAFE DRINKING
9 WATER, WATER QUALITY AND SUPPLY, FLOOD
10 CONTROL, RIVER AND COASTAL PROTECTION BOND
11 ACT OF 2006 (PROPOSITION 84) FOR THE CULVER
12 CITY BICYCLE AND PEDESTRIAN MASTER PLAN
13 UPDATE, THE GREEN STREETS POLICY (MONROVIA
14 PROJECT) AND THE CATCHMENT AND STORMWATER
15 IMPLEMENTATION PLAN (CLAREMONT PROJECT).

16 WHEREAS, the Legislature and Governor of the State of California have
17 provided funds for the Sustainable Communities Planning Grant and Incentives
18 Program under the Safe Drinking Water, Water Quality and Supply, Flood Control,
19 River and Coastal Protection Bond Act of 2006 (Proposition 84); and

20 WHEREAS, the Strategic Growth Council has been delegated the
21 responsibility for the administration of this grant program, establishing necessary
22 procedures; and

23 WHEREAS, said procedures require the City of Culver City to certify, by
24 resolution, the approval of the application before submission of the application(s) to the
25 State; and

26 WHEREAS, the City is applying as the Lead Agency, in collaboration with
27 California Green Communities as a sub-contractor, with partnerships with the cities of
28 Monrovia and Claremont; and

WHEREAS, the application is for grant funds for 1) the City of Culver
City's Bicycle and Pedestrian Master Plan Update; 2) the City of Monrovia's Green
Streets Policy; and 3) the City of Claremont's Catchment and Stormwater
Implementation Plan (collectively, "Projects"); and

1 WHEREAS, if the application is approved by the State, the City of Culver
2 City, as Lead Agency, will enter into an Agreement with the State of California to carry
3 out the development of the Projects.

4 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Culver City DOES
5 HEREBY RESOLVE:

6 1. The filing of an application with the State for Proposition 84 Funds
7 for the Projects is hereby approved; and

8 2. The City of Culver City hereby certifies that it understands the
9 assurances and certification in the application form; and

10 3. The City of Culver City hereby certifies that it will have sufficient
11 funds, as required by the grant program, to develop the Projects or will secure
12 the resources to do so; and

13 4. The City of Culver City hereby certifies the Projects will comply with
14 any applicable laws and regulations; and

15 5. The City Council hereby appoints the City Manager, or his
16 designee, to conduct all negotiations, and to execute and submit all documents
17 including, but not limited to, applications, agreements, amendments, payment
18 requests and so forth, which may be necessary for the completion of the
19 Projects.
