Application by Katya Bozzi, Executive Director of the ***STAR ECO STATION***, to conduct the 8th Annual African American Art Festival which includes crafts, games, food, music, live entertainment, and vendors on Saturday, February 2, 2008, from 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., at 10101 W. Jefferson Blvd., *provided that* all terms and conditions set forth by the Culver City Police Department, Planning Division, and Fire Prevention Bureau, are met and adhered to at all times. The event is free and outdoors. A plot plan was submitted to and approved by the Planning Division. Approximately 800 people are expected to attend. Previous permits have been issued.

The event is open to the public, an entrance fee will be charged. There will be vendors/booths. Approximately 200 people are expected to attend. Previous permits have been issued.

Application by Tom Trilling, President of the ***WESTWOOD CO-OP FOLK DANCERS***, to conduct a Folk Dance Festival at the Veterans' Memorial Complex on Sunday, April 6, 2008, from 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., *provided that* all terms and conditions set forth by the Culver City Police Department, Planning Division, and Fire Prevention Bureau, are met and adhered to at all times. The event is free and open to the public. Approximately 100-150 people are expected to attend. Previous permits have been issued.

9. **NOTICE OF INTENTION TO APPEAL OR SOLICIT**

Application by James Jacobs of the ***JACOBS' DELIVERANCE FOUNDATION and CORPORATION***, to conduct store front and door to door solicitation of cash/check donations to help feed homeless and needy families and to educate children, for one year beginning immediately after approval by the Committee on Permits and Licenses.
