

ORDINANCE NO. 2017 - _____

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CULVER CITY, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING TITLE 7, TRAFFIC CODE, CHAPTER 7.04, BICYCLES, OF THE CULVER CITY MUNICIPAL CODE, BY REPEALING AND RESERVING SECTIONS 7.04.200, 7.04.205, 7.04.210, 7.04.215, 7.04.220, 7.04.225, 7.04.230, 7.04.235, 7.04.240, 7.04.245, 7.04.255, 7.04.300, 7.04.305, 7.04.310 AND 7.04.415.

WHEREAS, various provisions of the Culver City Municipal Code (CCMC) relating to bicycle regulations duplicate or conflict with various provisions of the California Vehicle Code; and

WHEREAS, the 2010 Bicycle & Pedestrian Master Plan identified the need to modernize the CCMC provisions relating to bicycles regulations; and

WHEREAS, clarifying bicycle regulations will promote safe bicycling and help Culver City become a more bicycle-friendly community.

NOW THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Culver City, California, **DOES HEREBY ORDAIN** as follows:

SECTION 1. Sections 7.04.200, 7.04.205, 7.04.210, 7.04.215, 7.04.220, 7.04.225, 7.04.230, 7.04.235, 7.04.240, 7.04.245, 7.04.255, 7.04.300, 7.04.305, 7.04.310, and 7.04.415 of the Culver City Municipal Code, relating to bicycle regulations, are hereby repealed and reserved.

SECTION 2. Pursuant to Section 619 of the City Charter, this Ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after the date of its adoption. Pursuant to Sections 616 and 621 of the City Charter, prior to the expiration of fifteen (15) days after the adoption, the City Clerk

1 shall cause this Ordinance, or a summary thereof, to be published in the Culver City News
2 and shall post this Ordinance or a summary thereof in at least three places within the City.

4 **SECTION 3.** The City Council hereby declares that, if any provision, section,
5 subsection, paragraph, sentence, phrase or word of this ordinance is rendered or declared
6 invalid or unconstitutional by any final action in a court of competent jurisdiction or by reason
7 of any preemptive legislation, then the City Council would have independently adopted the
8 remaining provisions, sections, subsections, paragraphs, sentences, phrases or words of this
9 ordinance and as such they shall remain in full force and effect.
