

1 WHEREAS, the 2021 California Statewide Local Streets and Roads Needs
2 Assessment found that the City’s streets and roads are in an “at risk” condition and this
3 revenue will help the City increase the overall quality of its road system and over the next
4 decade will bring City streets and roads into a “good” condition; and

5 WHEREAS, the SB 1 project list and overall investment in the City’s local
6 streets and roads infrastructure, with a focus on basic maintenance and safety, investing in
7 complete streets infrastructure, and using cutting-edge technology, materials and practices,
8 will have significant positive co-benefits statewide.

9 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Culver City, California,
10 DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, as follows:

- 11 1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct.
- 12 2. The City Council hereby approves the following project for funding with

13 Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account revenues:

14 Project Title: Annual Street Paving Project Bristol Parkway (between Centinela
15 Avenue and Slauson Avenue)

16 Project Description: Grind and overlay of Bristol Parkway (between Centinela
17 Avenue and Slauson Avenue), including full depth removal and replacement of failed
18 pavement areas, replacement of damaged curb, gutter and sidewalk, and traffic
19 striping restoration and improvements

20 Project Location: Bristol Parkway (between Centinela Avenue and Slauson Avenue)

21 Estimated Project Schedule: Start (late 2026)– Completion (Spring 2027)

22 Estimated Project Useful Life: 15 – 20 years
