BACKGROUND

Monica Kilaita is being recognized by the City Attorney's Office for her Outstanding Job Performance. Since joining Culver City 18 months ago, Monica has proven herself to have the skill and judgement to expertly function in her role as Deputy City Attorney. For example, in her role as legal advisor to the Equity and Human Relations Advisory Committee, Monica has demonstrated her ability to work independently, with little to no supervision, while providing high quality legal guidance to City staff and the Committee on a multitude of complex and politically sensitive issues.

In addition to her regular duties, Monica is always ready and willing to step in to assist and collaborate on any number of issues. For example, during a three-week absence of another staff member, Monica handled the preparation of numerous contracts in order to keep the contract process running smoothly and provide the other City departments with a timely response. Monica also partnered with another member of our staff to create a Conflicts of Interest and Brown Act training (known as AB1234 training) for the City's elected and appointed officials, so that we are able to offer the training by our in-house professionals rather than an outside consultant.

Monica is an exceptional City employee and a valuable member of our Team, and it is with great pleasure that I nominate her for this Outstanding Performance Award.
