

1 WHEREAS, the 2016 California Statewide Local Streets and Roads Needs
2 Assessment found that the City's streets and roads are in an "at risk" condition and this
3 revenue will help the City increase the overall quality of its road system and over the next
4 decade will bring City streets and roads into a "good" condition; and

5 WHEREAS, the SB 1 project list and overall investment in the City's local
6 streets and roads infrastructure, with a focus on basic maintenance and safety, investing in
7 complete streets infrastructure, and using cutting-edge technology, materials and practices,
8 will have significant positive co-benefits statewide.

9 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Culver City, California,
10 DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, as follows:

 - 13 2. The City Council hereby approves the following list of projects planned
14 to be funded with Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account revenues:

- 15 • ***Sepulveda Boulevard from Venice Boulevard to the Southerly City***
16 ***Boundary Near Franklin Avenue, Project.*** This project involves the
17 replacement of three inches of asphalt and reconstruction of areas of
18 failed asphalt. The proposed schedule for construction is May 2023 to
19 August 2023 and the estimated useful life of the improvement will be 20
20 years.
