- How do we channel the energy of anger into acts for good in our personal lives, communities, the World?

The purpose of the Workshop (subject to further refinement) is to understand the genesis of anger in us, as humans - where it comes from (our primordial need to survive in stressful times: fight or flight response) - to inquire into how it appears to serve us - how we use and misuse it - and to reveal ways to transform it into a power for good and connection.

We are preparing to receive an **audience of about 100** or so people.

As part of our outreach/publicity efforts for this event, Candace has generously offered to write an article and submit it for publishing to some local Culver City news outlets where she has contacts.

And we request that this **event be in a hybrid format**, similar to the transgender day of remembrance event, such that audience members can join us virtually or in-person for the event...

We are also requesting a budget of up to \$100 for snacks. And an additional \$250 for an honorarium for our workshop presenter, Candace Carnicelli.
