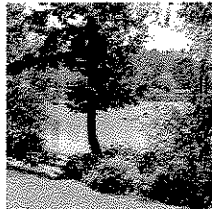

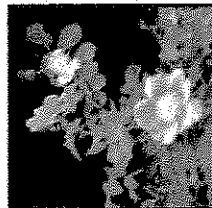

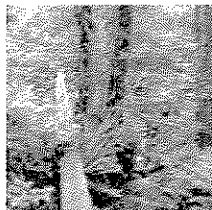


The Kitsap County program "*Dream to Reality*" offers you an opportunity to share a gift with your community that can be enjoyed today and for many generations to come.

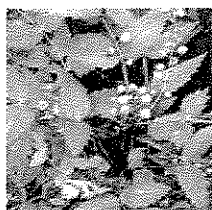
This gift catalog contains a wish list of items needed for Kitsap County Parks and Recreation Programs.

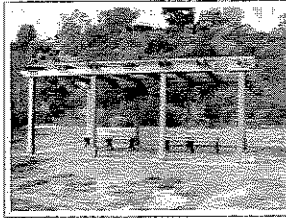
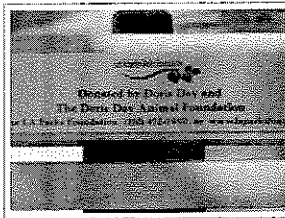
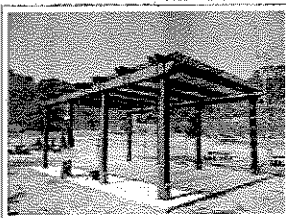
Barrington Recreation Center Refurbishments

Queen Anne Dug Out Benches

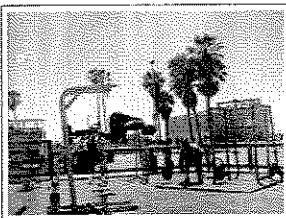
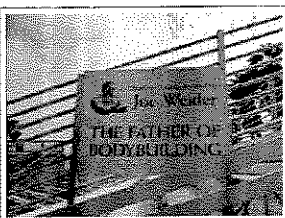
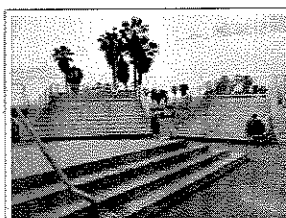

Laurel Canyon Dog Park Shade Structure


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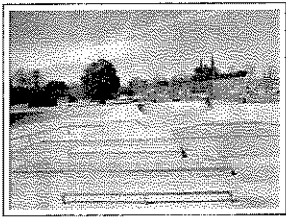
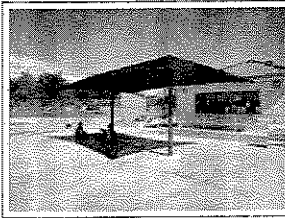
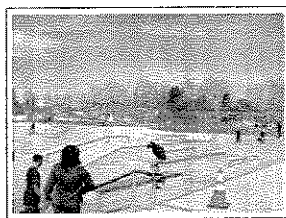

Venice Boardwalk Muscle Beach Bleachers



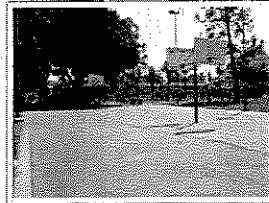
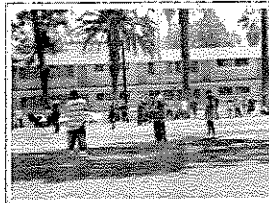
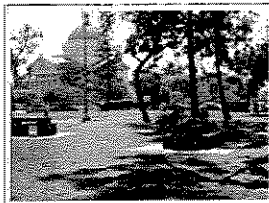
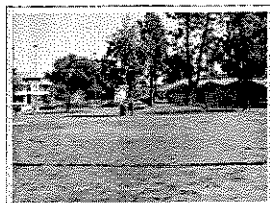

Pedlow Skate Park Shade Structure

Hoover Park Improvements
