Christina's strategic vision and proactive approach to addressing homelessness has been instrumental in the development of the Homeless Plan, implementation of Measure H Funds to assist the homeless, the development of the Motel Master Leasing and Nutrition Program, staffing the Advisory Committee on Housing and Homelessness, coordinating the annual census of the unhoused through the Los Angeles Homeless Services Authority Greater Los Angeles Homeless Count and securing the funds for the \$26 million dollar Project Homekey and assisting in the construction of the Project and overseeing the implementation of the program.

Through her tireless efforts to serve the unhoused in our community, Christina has helped to house over 100 of our unhoused neighbors, undoubtedly saving many lives. I am pleased to extend my heartfelt congratulations and sincere appreciation for the amazing work Christina Stoffers' performs for our unhoused neighbors.
