Subsidy Program Enrollment Criteria

Child(ren) between 4.5 years old - 12 years old

Enrolled in CCUSD elementary school:

- El Marino Elementary School
- El Rincon Elementary School
- Farragut Elementary School
- Linwood E. Howe Elementary School

Provide accurate documentation based on category

Attend 80% of program month



Category One

- Suffering from homelessness or living in a shelter.
- Active Child Protective Services (CPS) or At-Risk Services Referral
- Children in the foster care system
- 100% subsidized childcare

Category Two

- Lowest gross monthly income based on LA County Standard
- 50% subsidized childcare
- Children with exceptional needs* will be enrolled first

**Exceptional needs are defined as those who have physical, emotional or developmental impairments.*

Category Two: Monthly Income

FAMILY SIZE	FAMILY MONTHLY INCOME
1 person	\$35,000 a year---<\$2,917/month
2 persons	\$40,000 a year---<\$3,333/month
3 persons	\$45,000 a year---<\$3,750/month
4 persons	\$50,000 a year---<\$4,167/month
5 persons	\$54,000 a year---<\$4,500/month
6 persons	\$58,000 a year---<\$4,833/month

Information provided by Los Angeles County Lowest Gross Monthly Income

Category Three

- Families receiving state or county aid:
 - CalFresh, WIC, Snap Benefits, or CCUSD free lunches
 - 15% subsidized childcare

Application Process

Step 1: Complete
PRCS Subsidized
Childcare Application

Step 2: Provide
accurate required
documents

Step 3: Meet with
PRCS staff to review
handbook and
documents

Application Process

- Allow 3-5 business days for PRCS review of applications
- Families must submit any changes within 15 days, examples include:
 - Changes to income
 - Changes in referral services
 - Changes in housing
 - Changes to county or state benefits
- Failure to submit changes will result in loss of subsidy benefits
- Quarterly check-ins from PRCS via phone/email



Termination of Subsidy Benefits

Failure to report changes in income or other relevant information

Failure to comply with PRCS Code of Conduct

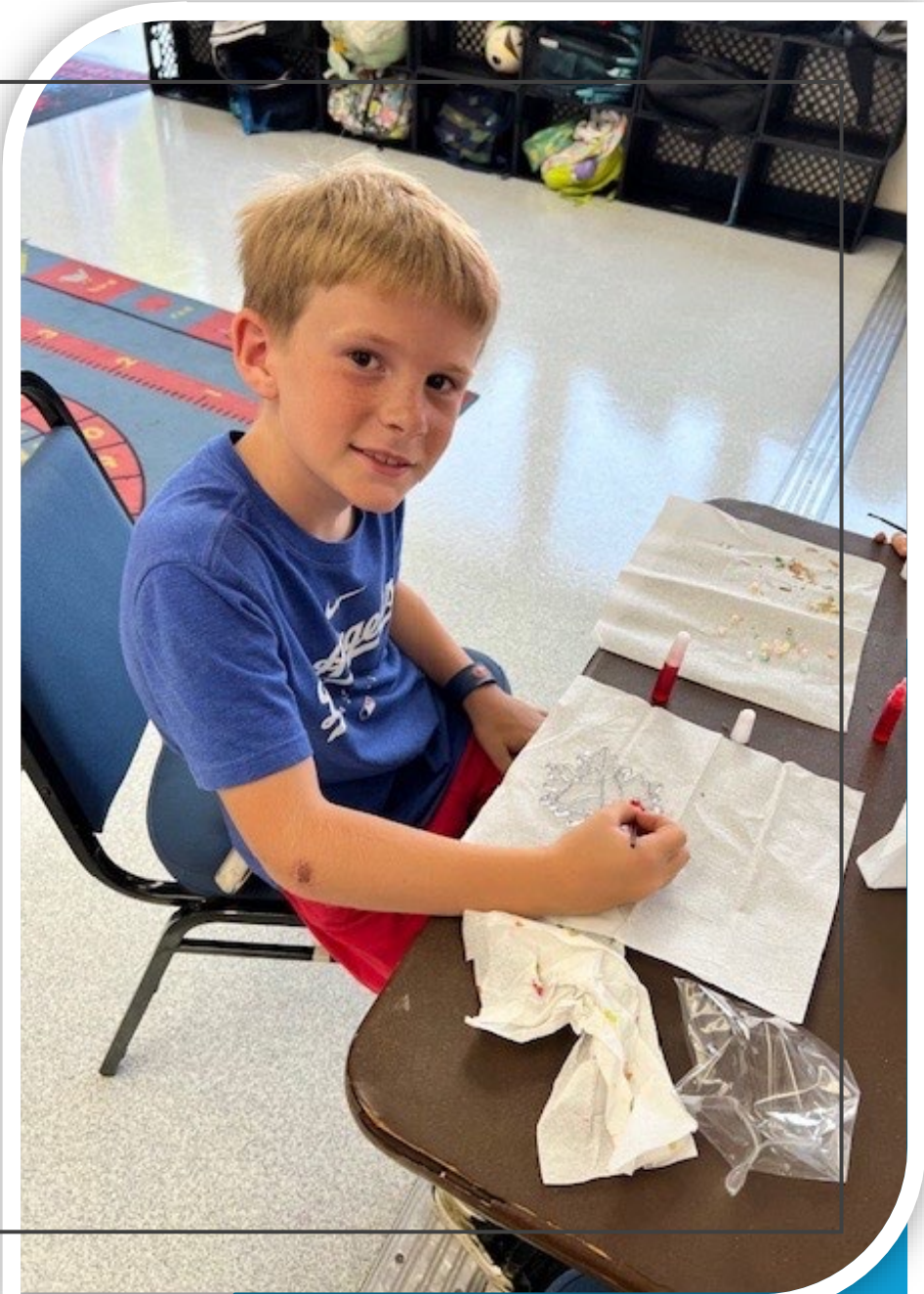
Failure to attend 80% of program month

Income exceeds LA County Lowest Gross Income



Important Information

- Subsidy currently only intended for Youth & Teen Programs
- Parents must sign handbook to complete application process
- Recreation program enrollment is not guaranteed
 - Based on space and funding
