

1 SECTION 3. A rebuttal argument may not be signed by more than five
2 authors. The rebuttal arguments shall be filed with the Elections Official, signed, with the
3 printed name(s) and signature(s) of the author(s) submitting it, or if submitted on behalf
4 of an organization, the name of the organization, and the printed name and signature of
5 at least one of its principal officers, not more than 10 days after the final date for filing
6 direct arguments. The rebuttal arguments shall be accompanied by the Form of
7 Statement To Be Filed By Author(s) of Argument. Rebuttal arguments shall be printed
8 in the same manner as the direct arguments. Each rebuttal argument shall immediately
9 follow the direct argument which it seeks to rebut.

10 SECTION 4. Any and all previous resolutions providing for the filing of
11 rebuttal arguments for city measures are repealed.

12 SECTION 5. The provisions set forth herein shall apply at the next
13 ensuing municipal election and at each municipal election after that time.

14 SECTION 6. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of
15 this Resolution and enter it into the book of original Resolutions.
