You will be called to the podium when it is your turn to address the City Council. Providing your name and other information requested on the Speaker's Card is voluntary and is requested only to provide a reasonable means to notify persons when their opportunity to address the City Council has All persons may attend the meeting regardless of whether a person arrived. signs, registers, or completes a speaker's card. For specific items listed on the agenda, requests to address the City Council must be made prior to the calling for a vote on that particular item by the presiding officer. Each speaker may address the City Council for up to three minutes (up to four minutes if time is Persons who are present in the City Council Chambers may cede one minute of time to one other person who is present and wishes to address the City Council by presenting a Speaker's Card to the City Clerk. Public comments on items on the agenda are taken at the time that particular agenda item is considered by the City Council.
