Each speaker may address the City Council for up to three minutes (up to four minutes if time is Persons who are present in the City Council Chambers may cede one minute of time to one other person who is present and wishes to address the City Council by presenting a Speaker's Card to the City Clerk. **Public** comments on items on the agenda are taken at the time that particular agenda item is considered by the City Council.
