PUBLIC COMMENT

At the times provided on the Agenda, members of the public shall have the opportunity to directly address the City Council, Commission, Committee, and/or Board on any item of interest to the public, before or during the consideration of the item, that is within the subject matter jurisdiction of the City Council, Commission, Committee and/or Board. The Legislative Body session cannot legally take action on any item not appearing on the agenda. Such items may be referred for administrative action or scheduled on a future agenda. If you wish to address the Legislative Body, the City Clerk/Secretary requests you complete and submit a Request to Speak Card prior to the agenda item being called. You will be called to the podium when it is your turn to address the Legislative Body. Providing your name and other information requested on the Request to Speak Card is voluntary and is requested only to provide a reasonable means to notify persons when their opportunity to address the Legislative Body has arrived. All persons may attend the meeting regardless of whether a person signs, registers, or completes a Request to For specific items listed on the agenda, requests to address the Speak Card. Legislative Body must be made prior to the calling for a vote on that particular item by the presiding officer. Each speaker may address the Legislative Body for up to three minutes (up to four minutes if time is ceded). Persons who are present in the City Council Chambers may cede one minute of time to one other person who is present and wishes to address the Legislative Body presenting a Request to Speak Card to the City Clerk/Secretary. comments on items on the agenda are taken at the time that particular agenda item is considered by the Legislative Body.

PUBLIC COMMENT - Items NOT On The Agenda

A total of twenty minutes shall be devoted to audience participation at the beginning of the agenda. Speakers will be called in the order cards were received by City staff. If additional time is needed, the Subcommittee chair will allow for some at the end of the agenda. When your name is called, please stand and state your name and city of residence. Speakers must limit their comments to three minutes (four minutes if time is ceded). Persons who are present in the Mike Balkman Council Chambers may cede one minute of time to one other person who is present and wishes to address the Subcommittee by presenting a Speaker's Card to the staff liaison.

RECEIPT OF CORRESPONDENCE

AUTHORITY OF PRESIDING OFFICER:

Section 611 of the City Charter provides that during any public meeting, all persons shall have the right to address the City Council, and any City commission, board or committee, subject to reasonable rules of decorum and time limits established by ordinance or the presiding officer. Therefore the presiding officer may, from time to time, establish different time limits than those listed on this Agenda in order to effectively conduct City business
