



General Plan Advisory Committee Notice of Cancellation

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Regular Meeting of the General Plan Advisory Committee scheduled for March 12, 2020, has been cancelled and shall not be held.

This morning, the City Manager directed staff to cancel all nonessential City-sponsored events of over 50 people. The City Manager's decision to cancel large gatherings is a precautionary measure. Currently, the Los Angeles County Department of Public Health and Centers for Disease Control (CDC) recommend social distancing when there is significant community transmission of the novel coronavirus. As of today, Los Angeles County has 17 confirmed cases of Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19), only one of which was community spread.

In a [recent press release](#), LA County Director of Public Health Barbara Ferrer, PhD, MPH, MEd, noted, "With the discovery of community spread yesterday, we will continue to see more cases of COVID-19 in LA County. With more cases, we are urging people with underlying health conditions, pregnant women and the elderly to practice social distancing by avoiding non-essential travel, public events, community gatherings, and indoor venues."

The City will continue to work closely with the Los Angeles County Department of Public Health to protect the health and safety of our Culver City residents, visitors and staff. [Learn more about the Coronavirus on the County's website.](#)
