MEETING INFORMATION AND ACCOMMODATION:

As a precaution and in order to slow the spread of the coronavirus (COVID-19), the Los Angeles County Department of Public Health has urged individuals to avoid non-essential gatherings. Similarly, the White House advised on March 16, 2020 for individuals not to gather in groups of more than 10 people. The Governor of California has urged home isolation for all seniors in the state of California 65 and older and those with chronic conditions. As such, the City urges you to consider not attending this meeting in-person; however, if you choose to attend in person, you should practice social distancing by maintaining a six-foot separation from other people at all times. The Council Chambers is now equipped with a hearing loop system. Hearing aid wearers with a "T" (telecoil) setting can now hear PA sound broadcast directly through their hearing aids. Others desiring hearing assistance may check out a portable receiver and headset.

PUBLIC COMMENT:

A Local and National Emergency has been declared regarding Coronavirus (COVID-19). Members of the public are strongly encouraged to submit their comments to the City Council via email to public.comment@culvercity.org. Social distancing measures are currently in place.

As a reminder, Culver City encourages community members to take precautions to stop the spread of COVID-19, such as frequent hand-washing, practicing social distancing and staying home when sick to lower the risk of spreading germs. If you are interested in addressing the City Council but you are an individual who is at higher risk for infection due to being over age 65, have a chronic health condition or a comprised immune system or generally feel unwell, please provide comments via email to vour public.comment@culvercity.org.

The City Council will receive comments from the public on any item of interest to the public (not listed on the agenda) that is within the subject matter jurisdiction of the City Council. The City Council cannot legally take action on any item not appearing on the agenda. Such items may be referred for administrative action or scheduled on a future agenda. If you wish to address the City Council, the City Clerk requests you complete a Speaker's Card and present it to the City Clerk before the agenda item is called. You will be called to the podium when it is your turn to address the City Council. Providing your name and other information requested on the Speaker's Card is voluntary and is requested only to provide a reasonable means to notify persons when their opportunity to address the City Council has arrived. All persons may attend the meeting regardless of whether a person signs, registers, or completes a speaker's card. For specific items listed on the agenda, all emailed requests to address the City Council must be made prior to the calling for a vote on that particular item by the presiding officer. Each speaker may address the City Council for up to three minutes (up to four minutes if time is ceded). Persons who are present in the City Council Chambers may cede one minute of time to one other person who is present and wishes to address the City Council by presenting a Speaker's Card to the City Clerk. Public comments on items on the agenda are taken at the time that particular agenda item is considered by the City Council.

AUTHORITY OF PRESIDING OFFICER:

Section 611 of the City Charter provides that during any public meeting, all persons shall have the right to address the City Council, and any City commission, board or committee, subject to reasonable rules of decorum and time limits established by ordinance or the presiding officer. Therefore the presiding officer may, from time to time, establish different time limits than those listed in this Agenda in order to effectively conduct City business. The presiding officer may also, from time to time, re-order the items on the agenda in order to effectively conduct the City Council meeting.

AVAILABILITY OF AGENDA PACKETS AND CONSERVATION OF RESOURCES:

Copies of the Agenda and a binder that includes a copy of all regular session staff reports and attachments are available on the table in the rear of the Council Chambers. Members of the public may inspect (at no cost) and/or obtain copies (upon payment of the City's current copying fee) of any regular session item by visiting the City Clerk's Office at City Hall.
