The meeting body will receive comments from the public on any item of interest to the public (not listed on the agenda) that is within the subject matter jurisdiction of the body. The meeting body cannot legally take action on any item not appearing on the agenda. Such items may be referred for administrative action or scheduled on a future agenda.

For specific items listed on the agenda, all emailed requests to address the meeting body must be submitted prior to the calling for a vote on that particular item by the presiding officer. Each speaker may address the meeting body for up to three minutes. Public comments on items on the agenda are taken at the time that particular agenda item is considered by the meeting body.

AUTHORITY OF PRESIDING OFFICER:

Section 611 of the City Charter provides that during any public meeting, all persons shall have the right to address the City Council, and any City commission, board or committee, subject to reasonable rules of decorum and time limits established by ordinance or the presiding officer. Therefore the presiding officer may, from time to time, establish different time limits than those listed on this Agenda in order to effectively conduct City business
