Please be advised, written comments WILL NOT be read aloud during the City Council Meeting.

The City Council will receive comments from the public on any item of interest to the public (not listed on the agenda) that is within the subject matter jurisdiction of the City Council. The City Council cannot legally take action on any item not appearing on the agenda. Such items may be referred for administrative action or scheduled on a future agenda.

Each speaker may address the City Council for up to three minutes. Public comments on items on the agenda are taken at the time that particular agenda item is considered by the City Council. A speaker, present in the meeting, may forfeit their time to speak to cede one minute of time to one other speaker per agenda item.
