Please be advised, written comments WILL NOT be read aloud during the City Council meeting.

ORAL COMMENTS: Please register to attend the meeting via Webex at culvercity.org/agendas and indicate the agenda item(s) for which you wish to make a comment. This will serve as a virtual speaker card. Speakers will be called in chronological order, based on when they registered to attend. Each speaker may address the City Council for up to three minutes. Public comments on items on the agenda are taken at the time that particular agenda item is considered by the City Council. A speaker, present in the meeting, may forfeit their entire time to speak to cede one minute of time to one other speaker per agenda item.

AUTHORITY OF PRESIDING OFFICER:

Section 611 of the City Charter provides that during any public meeting, all persons shall have the right to address the City Council, and any City commission, board or committee, subject to reasonable rules of decorum and time limits established by ordinance or the presiding officer. Therefore, the presiding officer may, from time to time, establish different time limits than those listed in this Agenda in order to effectively conduct City business. The presiding officer may also, from time to time, re-order the items on the agenda in order to effectively conduct the City Council meeting.
