There are paving gaps at several intersections on Braddock that are very dangerous for bikes. These gaps about a foot into the street are left

from the removal of the concrete forms when pouring new pedestrian cross walk concrete aprons at certain corners. Usually

these gaps are filled later with asphalt. These are serious accidents waiting to happen as they can capture a typical narrow bike tire and throw the rider.

Several years ago I reported this issue in person to a member of the Bicycle Committee as well as a member of Public works.

Since my concerns seem to have - all puns intended- fallen unheard into the cracks I am now providing a written report and photos, as

I am now myself a regular bike rider on Braddock and noticed the problem still exists.

Probably there are other places in the city with the same situation. If public works could be made aware of these innocuous seeming traps

and get proactive when on other paving jobs would that not be nice!

Thank you for your attention to this public safety issue. A friend recently broke his arm falling off his bike in LA caught in a similar situation.





Trash pile at the End of Cattaraugus Ave on the bike path


