Event elements.

One or two local historians with Q&A, 6 minutes each

A translator for the stories and historians' remarks

volunteer "whisperers" who would sit in the audience to translate during each Q&A session (5-6 volunteers)

Student art on display. Possibly a silent auction to auction off the art.

<u>Music</u> Spanish songs sung by students from El Marino and La Ballona elementary schools and Folklorico music and dance by Culver City Middle School students

Aztec dancers. If we are able to engage Aztec dancers, they would dance at the beginning of the celebration.

<u>A booklet</u> containing basic Culver City history with a focus on Latinos, as well as art, and a listing of Latinexowned businesses. The booklet would contain a request to support the Latinx-owned businesses included in the booklets.
