2	AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CULVER CITY, CALIFORNIA,
3	AMENDING SECTIONS 3.05.010 AND 3.05.020 OF CHAPTER 3.05 "PERSONNEL POLICIES" OF THE CULVER CITY
4	MUNICIPAL CODE, TO BE CONSISTENT WITH CHANGES TO RULE 3 "CLASSIFICATION," OF THE CIVIL SERVICE RULES.
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6	The City Council of the City of Culver City, California, DOES HEREBY
7	ORDAIN as follows:
8	SECTION 1: Section 3.05.010 of the Culver City Municipal Code is hereby
9	amended to read as follows:
10	§ 3.05.010 CIVIL SERVICE RULES.
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12	In addition to such other rules as the Civil Service Commission may determine are necessary and proper to carry out the intent and purpose of the
13	personnel program, the following duties, tasks and principles shall be addressed in the Civil Service Rules:
14	A. Preparation, installation, revision and maintenance of a position
15	classification plan covering all positions in the Classified Service, including employment standards and qualifications for
16	each class. B. Preparation, revision, and administration of a plan of
17	compensation directly correlated with the position classification plan, providing a rate or range of pay for each class.
18	C. Public announcement of all tests and the acceptance of
19	applications for employment. D. Preparation and conduct of tests and the establishment and use
20	of resulting eligible lists containing names of persons eligible for appointment.
21	E. Certification and appointment of persons from eligible lists, and
22	making of temporary appointments. F. Evaluation of employees during the probationary period.
23	G. Transfer, promotion, demotion and reinstatement of employees
24	in the Classified Service. H. Separation of employees from municipal service through layoff,
25	suspension and dismissal. I. Standardization of hours of work, attendance and leave
26	regulations, working conditions and the development of employee morale, welfare, education and training.
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1	J. Suitable provision for orderly and equitable presentations to the Council by employees relating to general conditions of employment.
2	K. Content, maintenance and use of personnel records and forms.
3	SECTION 2: Section 3.05.020 of the Culver City Municipal Code is hereby
4 5	amended to read as follows:
5 6	§ 3.05.020 PERSONNEL OFFICER; DUTIES.
7	A. Designation of officer. The Personnel Officer shall be the City Manager, or such person as appointed by the City Manager.
8	Duties may be combined with those of any other office or
9	position, provided the appointee shall have had training or experience in personnel administration.
10	B. Duties.
11	1. Attend all meetings of the Civil Service Commission and serve as liaison officer between the City Manager and the Civil
12	Service Commission. 2. Administer all of the provisions of the Rules not
13	2. Administer all of the provisions of the Rules not specifically reserved to the City Council, the Civil Service
14	Commission, or the City Manager. 3. Assist the Civil Service Commission in the preparation,
	study and analysis of Rules and revisions and amendments
15	thereto, for submission to the City Council after approval by City Attorney as to legality of such action.
16	4. Assist the Civil Service Commission in the periodic study
17	and analysis of salaries paid by other public and private agencies, at the discretion of the City Council, as set forth in
18	Section 3.03.100 of this Code.
19	5. Encourage the improvement of municipal service by studying needs and recommending programs for education and
20	training to the City Manager; such programs becoming effective
21	upon approval by the Civil Service Commission and the City Council.
22	SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. Pursuant to Section 619 of the City
23	Charter this Ordinance shall take affect thirty (20) days after its adaption
24	Charter, this Ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after its adoption.
25	SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY. The City Council hereby declares that, if
26	any provision, section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, phrase or word of this
27	Ordinance is rendered or declared invalid or unconstitutional by any final action in a court
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1	of competent jurisdiction or by reason of any preemptive legislation, then the City Council
2	would have independently adopted the remaining provisions, sections, subsections,
3	paragraphs, sentences, phrases or words of this Ordinance and as such they shall
4	remain in full force and effect.
5	SECTION 5. PUBLICATION. Pursuant to Sections 616 and 621 of the City
6	Charter, prior to the expiration of fifteen (15) days after the adoption, the City Clerk shall
7	cause this Ordinance, or a summary thereof, to be published in the Culver City News
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9	and shall post this Ordinance or a summary thereof in at least three places within the
10	City.
