Discussion ensued between Ms. Womack, staff, and Subcommittee Members regarding the optimal viewpoint for the artwork vs. viewing from all different perspectives; ensuring the piece runs parallel to the train tracks; lighting concerns and concepts; updated renderings to refine the concept; vetting of the concept by Metro and by the City landscape architect and civil engineers; MOVE Culver City; the budget; the artist fee; consultation with arborists; ensuring the full scope is clear; the construction drawing package; City Council approval of the concept and costs; whether the structure can be built around the tree; creativity working around constraints; pulling out the arborist component; feasibility; groundwater levels; removal of the four palm trees; Transit Oriented Development (TOD) design; redevelopment; concern with asking two bodies to approve the project with unknown variables; the survey of the site; concern with having to go back for approval twice; ensuring that it is clear what the site can support; the importance of the tree; direction from the City Council to augment rather than to destroy; enhance and recommendations based upon knowledge; ensuring competitive numbers; soil surveys; materials; length of the process; showing a commitment; compensation so far; time and money put into the process; spending time and money now to present the whole picture; scheduling; the payment schedule; presentation; the renderings; the meeting with Metro; the streetscape plan; the public process; items to complete before going to the Cultural Affairs Commission; moving forward with a preliminary geotechnical and arborist report; contractor selection; pricing; the contract between the artist and the City; logistics; and scheduling.
