

1 **RESOLUTION NO. 2022-R_____**

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3 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
4 CULVER CITY, CALIFORNIA, ACCEPTING GRANT FUNDS
5 FROM THE FEDERAL TRANSPORTATION AGENCY (FTA).

6 WHEREAS, the Federal Transportation Agency's (FTA) competitive Route
7 Planning Restoration Grant Program is part of the American Rescue Plan Act and is for the
8 planning of transit service restoration in light of the major impact experienced both locally
9 and nationally from the COVID-19 Pandemic; and

10 WHEREAS, after submitting its application in the fall of 2021, the City was
11 selected as one of 50 transit agencies nationwide and one of only two agencies in Los
12 Angeles County to receive a grant award under the Route Planning Restoration Grant
13 Program; and

14 WHEREAS, the City's grant request in the amount of \$645,750 was fully
15 funded by the FTA, which will fund the City's preparation of a comprehensive service
16 analysis of citywide transit services. This project is aligned with the City's Short-Range
17 Mobility Plan.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Culver City, DOES
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20 HEREBY RESOLVE as follows:

21 1. Accepts the Route Planning Restoration grant award in the amount of
22 \$645,750 from the Federal Transportation Agency; and

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2. Appoints the City Manager, or designee, as agent to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents including, but not limited to, application, agreements and payment requests, which may be necessary for receipt of the grant award.
