<u>Overview</u>---For FY 2022/23, the EHRAC approved various events as part of its work program. One event is participation in the worldwide observation of the Transgender Day of Remembrance (TDOR). The TGDOR has been observed in 185 cities, including many in the United States, around the world in more than 20 countries since 1999 to commemorate the killing during the past year of Transgender and Gender Non-Binary people, and to tell a bit of their story.
