

1 Emergency finding that the conditions of extreme peril did warrant and necessitate
2 the proclamation of the existence of a Local Emergency; and

3 **WHEREAS**, pursuant to California Government Code section 8630(d), the
4 governing body shall proclaim the termination of a Local Emergency at the earliest
5 possible date that conditions warrant; and

6 **WHEREAS**, nationally, the Biden administration has announced that it will
7 allow the coronavirus public health emergency and national emergency to expire on
8 May 11, 2023, announcing the termination over 90 days in advance to allow time for
9 healthcare institutions to prepare for the end to the emergency; and

10 **WHEREAS**, the State of California's COVID-19 State of Emergency ended
11 on February 28, 2023; and

12 **WHEREAS**, on February 28, 2023, the Los Angeles County Board of
13 Supervisors unanimously approved terminating the County's COVID-19 emergency
14 declaration effective March 31, 2023; and

15 **WHEREAS**, the City of Los Angeles ended its state of emergency due to
16 COVID-19 on February 1, 2023, and the City of Santa Monica ended its health
17 emergency for the COVID-19 pandemic on February 28, 2023.

18 **WHEREAS**, on February 27, 2023, in consideration of the current public
19 health conditions, the City Council directed the City Manager to return to City Council
20 with a resolution terminating the COVID-19 local emergency, effective April 1, 2023.

21 **NOW, THEREFORE**, the City Council of the City of Culver City, California,
22 **DOES HEREBY RESOLVE** as follows:
