- About 30% of our patients are also Regional Center clients

- Who can access the exam table?
- What would happen if someone was yelling in the waiting room?
- Is there room in an exam room for a person using a wheelchair, the doctor and a couple of support people?
- How long do you have to tell your story?

AT ACHIEVABLE

- Who can be weighed?
 - Almost anyone! Wheelchair scale, scale that is flat to the ground, exam tables that can weigh people and measure length
- Who can access the exam tables?
 - Almost anyone! Special exam tables that go very low to the floor, are wide, have handles. Hoyer lift for transfers.
- What would happen if someone was yelling in the waiting room?
 - Staff with training and desire to meet the needs of each individual patient
- Is there enough room in the exam room?
 - Yes!
- How long do you have to tell your story?
 - Extended visit times for patients who need it.
