RESOLUTION NO. 2023-R 1 2 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF 3 CALIFORNIA, APPROVING THE CULVER CITY, ASSESSMENT ENGINEER'S REPORT, DECLARING ITS 4 INTENTION TO ORDER THE ANNUAL LEVY AND COLLECTION OF ASSESSMENTS FOR THE BENEFIT 5 DISTRICT WEST ASSESSMENT WASHINGTON 6 BOULEVARD NO. 3, AND SETTING A TIME AND PLACE FOR A PUBLIC HEARING THEREON. 7 8 9 WHEREAS, the City Council previously initiated proceedings in 10 accordance with the provisions of Chapter 15.01 of the Culver City Municipal Code 11 ("CCMC") for the levy and collection of annual assessments for the Benefit Assessment 12 District West Washington Boulevard No. 3 (the "District") and ordered the preparation of 13 an Assessment Engineer's Report (the "Engineer's Report") thereon; and 14 15 WHEREAS, the City Council desires to declare its intention to provide for 16 the levy and collection of annual assessments for Fiscal Year 2023-2024, to provide for 17 the costs and expenses necessary to pay for the maintenance and servicing of the 18 improvements (defined below) within the District; and, 19 WHEREAS, the Engineer's Report has been prepared and filed with the 20 City Clerk and submitted to the City Council in accordance with Sections 15.01.055 and 21 22 15.01.070 of the CCMC; and, 23 WHEREAS, the City Council has carefully examined and reviewed the 24 Engineer's Report as presented and is preliminary satisfied with the proposed report, 25 each and all of the budget items and documents as set forth therein and is satisfied that 26 the levy amounts, on a preliminary basis, have been spread in accordance with the 27

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special benefit received from the improvements, operation, maintenance and services within the District as set forth in the Engineer's Report.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Culver City, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE as follows:

1. The Engineer's Report as presented, consisting of the following: a description of improvements, the estimated costs of improvements, a diagram of the District and the District assessment roll containing the Fiscal Year 2023-2024 levy for each Assessor's parcel within the District, is hereby approved on a preliminary basis and ordered to be filed in the Office of the City Clerk as a permanent record and to remain open for public inspection.

12 2. It is the intention of the City Council to levy and collect 13 assessments within the District to pay the annual costs and expenses for the 14 maintenance and servicing of the improvements authorized to be maintained and serviced for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2023 and ending June 30, 2024. The 16 improvements include: seven medians, landscaping, lighting, irrigation and appurtenant 17 facilities including any other improvements authorized by the CCMC within the 18 19 boundaries of the District. Services provided include all necessary service, operations, 20 administration and maintenance required to keep the improvements in a healthy, 21 vigorous and satisfactory condition. 22

3. The District is located generally between Beethoven Street and 23 Glencoe Avenue. The District is designated by the name of "Benefit Assessment 24 District West Washington Boulevard No. 3." 25

26 The Engineer's Report, as preliminary approved by the City 4. 27 Council, is on file with the City Clerk and open for public inspection. Reference is made

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to the Engineer's Report for a full detailed description of the improvements to be maintained, the boundaries of the District and the proposed assessments upon assessable lots and parcels of land within the District.

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The maximum assessment is not proposed to increase from the 5. previous year above that previously approved by the property owners (as "increased assessment" is defined in Section 54954.6 of the California Government Code).

Notice is hereby given that a Public Hearing is scheduled to be held 6. on June 12, 2023 at 7:00pm, or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, in the Mike Balkman Council Chambers at City Hall and via video conference. Instructions on 10 how to attend this hearing will be included in the published notice. All interested 12 persons, prior to the conclusion of the hearing, shall be afforded the opportunity to hear 13 The City Council shall consider all oral statements or written and be heard. 14 communication made or filed by any interested person. 15

7. The City Clerk is hereby directed to give notice of the Public 16 Hearing by causing this resolution of intention, or summary thereof, to be published, 17 posted and mailed as provided in Section 15.01.050 of the CCMC. 18
