

1 RESOLUTION NO. 2016-R_____

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3 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
4 CULVER CITY, CALIFORNIA, (1) RESCINDING
5 RESOLUTION NO. 2015-R063 (LEVEL 2 WATER SUPPLY
6 SHORTAGE CONDITIONS); AND (2) DECLARING THE
7 EXISTENCE OF LEVEL 1 WATER SUPPLY SHORTAGE
8 CONDITIONS AND IMPLEMENTING MANDATORY
9 CONSERVATION REQUIREMENTS.

10 WHEREAS, on November 9, 2009, the City Council adopted Chapter 5.03
11 of the Culver City Municipal Code (CCMC), establishing the Culver City Water
12 Conservation and Water Supply Shortage Program (the "Program"); and

13 WHEREAS, in accordance with the Program, the permanent water
14 conservation requirements set forth in CCMC Sections 5.03.030 are effective at all
15 times (collectively, "Permanent Requirements"); and

16 WHEREAS, the State of California has imposed permanent water
17 regulations (collectively, "State Regulations") for all water users, which prohibit the
18 following:

- 19 1. Using potable water to irrigate ornamental turf on public street
20 medians;
- 21 2. Using potable water to irrigate landscapes of new homes & buildings
22 inconsistent with CBSC & DHCD requirements;
- 23 3. Using outdoor irrigation during and 48 hours following measurable
24 precipitation;
- 25 4. Using potable water in decorative water features that do not recirculate
26 the water;
- 27 5. Using hoses with no shutoff nozzles to wash cars;
- 28 6. Runoff when irrigating with potable water; and
7. Using potable water to wash sidewalks and driveways and

29 WHEREAS, Golden State Water ("GSW") and the Los Angeles
30 Department of Water and Power "LADWP" have imposed additional water restrictions
31 for their customers (collectively, "Restrictions"), which have received approval of the

1 California Water Resources Control Board, which limit outdoor irrigation to a maximum
2 of three days per week; and

3 WHEREAS, pursuant to CCMC Section 5.03.050, the City Council may,
4 by resolution, declare the existence of Level 1, Level 2 or Level 3 Water Supply
5 Shortage conditions and impose related mandatory conservation requirements; and

6 WHEREAS, on July 13, 2015 at a duly noticed public meeting, after
7 hearing all testimony and receiving all written comments, the City Council adopted
8 Resolution No. 2015-R063, declaring the existence of a Level 2 Water Supply Shortage
9 condition and imposing the related mandatory Level 2 conservation requirements; and

11 WHEREAS, in response to Executive Order B-37-16 "Making Water
12 Conservation a California Way of Life" signed by Governor Jerry Brown on May 9, 2016
13 ("Order"); and

14 WHEREAS, on September 26, 2016, at a duly noticed public meeting,
15 after hearing all testimony and receiving all written comments, the City Council: (1)
16 rescinded Resolution No. 2015-R063 (Level 2 Water Supply Shortage conditions); and
17 (2) declared the existence of Level 1 Water Supply Shortage conditions and imposed
18 the related mandatory Level 1 conservation requirements.

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20 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Culver City, DOES
21 HEREBY RESOLVE as follows:

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23 1. Resolution No. 2015-R063, which declared a Level 2 Water Supply
24 Shortage condition and implemented related mandatory Level 2 conservation
25 requirements, is hereby rescinded.

26 2. Pursuant to CCMC Section 5.03.035.A, the City Council hereby
27 finds that, due to drought and water supply conditions, a water supply shortage exists
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1 and a consumer-demand reduction is necessary to make more efficient use of water
2 and appropriately respond to existing water conditions.

3 3. Pursuant to CCMC Section 5.03.050 and the recitations and
4 findings herein, the City Council hereby declares the existence of Level 1 Water Supply
5 Shortage conditions.

6 4. In addition to the Permanent Requirements, State Regulations, the
7 Order and Restrictions currently in effect, the City Council hereby imposes the
8 additional water conservation requirements set forth in CCMC Sections 5.03.035.B.1
9 and 5.03.035.B.2 (mandatory Level 1 conservation measures).

10 5. Pursuant to CCMC Section 5.03.050, the new water conservation
11 requirements set forth in Section 4 of this Resolution shall take effect on October 6,
12 2016.

13 6. Within five days following the adoption of this Resolution, the City
14 Clerk shall cause a copy of this Resolution to be published in a newspaper used for
15 publication of official City notices.
