1 WHEREAS, Proposition 57 would potentially lead to early release for  
2 offenders convicted of "non-violent crimes," many of which seem more properly  
3 categorized as violent, including throwing acid with the intent to disfigure, and discharging a  
4 firearm from a motor vehicle, to name a few, and this triggers concerns that offenders who  
5 committed offenses widely regarded as violent will be provided undue leniency; and

6 WHEREAS, Proposition 57 could increase the likelihood of parole for persons  
7 convicted of "non-violent" felonies after completing the full term for his or her primary  
8 offense, and by disqualifying earned enhancements; and

9 WHEREAS, the passage of Proposition 57 may result in undetermined but  
10 negative consequences to public safety and well-being for California's cities and residents  
11 alike.

12 NOW THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Culver City does hereby  
13 resolve as follows:
